Up to **5 households** at any one time

FURTHER POINTS TO NOTE



No religious rites or ceremonies allowed

No mixing between households



Attendees are immediate family members of couple, with the exception of **two witnesses**. There should not be any post-event reception with food and drinks.



10 person cap excludes religious workers



Live singing is discouraged unless can be done safely

Stay at home and avoid going out where possible.

Practise safe distancing, observe good personal hygiene and wear a mask when outside of your home.

All Religious Organisations must implement Safe Management Plans before re-opening and to submit these within 2 weeks of re-opening to MCCY.
